

- 2015-025 Mulch and green waste dumped into drainage channel caught fire. Visited site and discussed County ordinances with property owner. Will follow-up after safety issues are addressed
- 2015-026 Resident concerned about condition of water in Goleta Slough, no illicit discharge detected during site visit, observed large mats of decaying algae, discussed the site conditions with City of Goleta and UCSB staff, conditions normal for time of year.
- 2015-027 Strong odor from storm drain, some staining on roadway may indicate dumping, interviewed and educated surrounding property managers, storm drain was cleaned out.
- 2015-028 Power washing exterior of building, wash water running into gutter. Work was stopped until the patio drain was covered. Wash water was captured and disposed properly.
- 2015-029 Complaint of dead seals and trash on beach, carcasses and trash were removed
- 2015-031 Complaint of easy chair dumped in creek, County Flood Control removed the chair.
- 2015-035 Oil on sand and in water at beach, source is combination of natural seeps and improperly capped abandoned on shore wells. California State Lands Commission working to remediate.
- 2015-037 Dark brown water discharging to creek, Water District confirmed tank flushing, discharge is allowed. Water District will notify of future flushing.
- 2015-041 Encampment on beach, location was cleaned by contractor
- 2015-043 Report of wastewater from residence discharged into drainage channel, owners notified of discharge prohibitions, no further discharges observed
- 2015-044 Well drilling slurry discharged into street gutter. Environmental Health Services responded.
- 2015-045 Report of tanker truck dumping unknown liquid onto roadway near creek. No evidence of discharge was observed during site visit.
- 2015-047 Large amount of water in drainage ditch flowing to creek, contacted surrounding property owners, flow is agricultural tailwater and not regulated by the County
- 2015-048 Trash pile near creek, trash removed by County Flood Control
- 2015-050 Homeless encampment near creek, location was cleaned by contractor
- 2016-001 5 gallon container of unidentified liquid resembling used motor discovered next to creek. Consulting with Certified Unified Program Agency who identified, removed and properly disposed of the oil
- 2016-002 vehicle leaked transmission fluid on street in front of County building, referred to City of SB Creeks who responded with City Fire to clean up the spill
- 2016-003 Homeless encampment near creek, location was cleaned by contractor
- 2016-004 Trash and recyclables from dumpster area being wind blown into creek, fencing will be installed to contain the debris
- 2016-005 Green waste and manure dumped on creek bank, property owner contacted, resolution pending

2016-006 concrete residue in creek discovered by PCW and CDFW staff, both spoke with homeowner who then cleaned up the site

2016-007 PCW staff observed a restaurant employee hosing down the used oil storage area and runoff was flowing into the gutter. Employee was directed to stop and the case was referred to Environmental Health

2016-008 Water discharged from basin on construction site, complaint being handled by County Building and Safety Division, resolution pending

2016-009 Report of oil and tar on rocks and in the water in a creek. PCW and Flood Control staff responded, no spills were found, area has history of natural seepage

2016-010 Homeless encampment near creek, location was cleaned by contractor

2016-011 Report of sediment left on street after work was performed in the area, confirmed water district repairs happening in that location, area was cleaned when work was completed

2016-012 Mobile car washing on street with soap and rinse water running in gutter, workers were informed of the discharge regulations

2016-014 Report of trash in County bioswale, removed by County staff

2016-015 PCW staff discovered water softener equipment and salt dumped on bank of creek, property owners were notified and they cleaned the site

2016-016 Police officer observed dirt being dumped into drainage channel, citation issued.

2016-018 Restaurant discharging greasy wash water into creek, referred case to Environmental Health, resolution pending

2016-023 Garbage dumped in creek, removed by County staff

2016-024 Automotive fluids in the street from leaky vehicle, owner was notified and used dry methods to clean the area, took the truck in for repairs

2016-026 Trash dumped on creek bank, area cleaned by contractor

2016-030 Report of unknown liquid dumped in drainage, surrounding neighbors notified of discharge regulations

2016-037 Report of dumping in creek, surrounding neighbors notified of discharge regulations

2016-038 Construction waste leaked out of dumpster and hosed down parking lot, owner notified of discharge regulations

2016-039 Powerwashing waste water flowing into gutter, crew stopped work and used wet vacuum to clean gutter, letter to owner

2016-041 Homeless camp on beach, location cleaned by contractor
